- (c) The governing body of Calvert County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county property tax imposed on a building [other than a tobacco barn] that is:
 - (1) located on land that qualifies for an agricultural use assessment; and
- (2) used in connection with an activity that is recognized by the Department as an approved agricultural activity.
