SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 38 – Fines and Forfeitures

5.

(E) IN CALVERT COUNTY, IF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE CONSIDERS THE MONEY AVAILABLE FROM FINES IN EXCESS OF THE NEEDS OF THE LIBRARY, ALL OR PART OF THE EXCESS MONEY MAY BE USED FOR OTHER CIRCUIT COURT NEEDS IF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ARE PROVIDED WITH AN ANNUAL REPORT DOCUMENTING HOW THE MONEY IS USED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October 1, 1992~~ June 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 180

(House Bill 698)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County – Housing Projects

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Calvert County to provide certain funds for financing housing or housing projects in the county; authorizing the County Commissioners to record certain instruments on certain property to ensure repayment of certain funds; specifying that the County Commissioners may implement the provisions of this Act only by certain resolutions; requiring the County Commissioners to hold a certain public hearing and publish a certain notice; and generally relating to financing housing and housing projects in Calvert County.
