

(B) GROSSLY NEGLIGENT VIOLATION.

A PERSON WHO COMMITS A GROSSLY NEGLIGENT VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE OR WHO CAUSES A PERSON TO COMMIT A GROSSLY NEGLIGENT VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$3,000 OR LIABILITY FOR RESTITUTION THAT THE COURT DETERMINES OR BOTH.

In subsections (a) and (b) of this section, the former references to "the same penalties as the entity" are deleted because the penalties are specified.

6-701. SHORT TITLE.

THIS TITLE IS THE MARYLAND CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS ACT.

The former word "[o]rganization" is deleted as too restrictive because this title applies to charitable representatives as well as charitable organizations.
