identification cards; authorizing the Administration to suspend the registration of a vehicle involved in certain parking violations under certain circumstances; authorizing the Administration to adopt certain rules and regulations; requiring the Administration to continue a certain suspension until a certain event; prohibiting a person from driving a vehicle if the registration has been suspended under this Act; providing for a certain penalty; and generally relating to motor vehicle registration and driver's licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

12-301.

(g)

- (2) The card shall contain:
 - (i) The name and address of the applicant;
 - (ii) The birth date of the applicant;
 - (iii) The sex of the applicant;
 - (iv) A description of the applicant;
- (v) A color photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that the Administration requires. Photographs issued to applicants under 21 years of age will be taken with the profile view. A fee [of \$3], AS ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, is required for the conversion to a regular full face photo identification card after the age of 21;
 - (vi) The expiration date of the identification card;
 - (vii) The signature of the applicant; and
 - (viii) The signature and seal of the issuing agent.
- (i) An identification card expires every [4] 5 years. It may be renewed on application and payment of the fee required by this section.
