SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Transportation**

(g)

(2) The card shall contain:

(i) The name and address of the applicant;

(ii) The birth date of the applicant;

(iii) The sex of the applicant;

(iv) A description of the applicant;

(v) A color photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that the Administration requires. Photographs issued to applicants under 21 years of age will be taken with the profile view. A fee [of \$3], AS ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, is required for the conversion to a regular full face photo identification card after the age of 21;

(vi) The expiration date of the identification card;

(vii) The signature of the applicant; and

(viii) The signature and seal of the issuing agent.

(i) An identification card expires every [4] 5 years. It may be renewed on application and payment of the fee required by this section.
