SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-605.

- (a) The temporary registration of a vehicle under this part expires on the first to occur of:
 - (1) Receipt of annual registration plates for the vehicle;
 - (2) Rescission of the contract to buy the vehicle; or
 - (3) Expiration of 45 days from the date the temporary plate was issued.
- (B) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY EXTEND THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION FOR A VEHICLE UNDER THIS PART FOR A PERIOD OF NOT TO EXCEED 30 DAYS IF THE BUYER: IF THE ADMINISTRATION IS SATISFIED THAT REASONABLE CONDITIONS EXIST TO JUSTIFY THE GRANTING OF THIS EXTENSION.
- (1) APPLIES, ON A FORM REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION, FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION; AND
- (2) SUPPLIES PROOF SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT ALL REQUIRED FEES, TAXES, AND CHARGES HAVE BEEN PAID BY THE BUYER TO A DEALER.
- [(b)] (C) The person to whom a temporary registration plate has been issued for a vehicle shall destroy the temporary registration plate as soon as the temporary registration expires.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
