Public Service Commission proceedings under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Department from issuing permits to construct electric generating stations; requiring the Department to request that the Public Service Commission hold hearings under certain circumstances; requiring the Department, except in certain circumstances, to consult with the Public Service Commission before taking certain enforcement actions; prohibiting the Secretary from requiring certain permits or the payment of certain fees; requiring the Public Service Commission to include certain standards in a certificate of public convenience and necessity under certain circumstances; requiring that certain installations of equipment and changes in methods of operations at electric generating stations be subject to a certain prior review and approval by the Public Service Commission; and generally relating to air operating permits for electric companies.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

2-402.

The Department may not require a permit or registration for:

- (1) Any machinery or equipment that normally is used in a mobile manner;
- (2) Any boiler used exclusively to operate steam engines for farm and domestic use;
- (3) [Any] THE CONSTRUCTION OF A generating station constructed by an electric company;
