CHAPTER 196
(House Bill 1221)

AN ACT concerning

Allegany County – Salary Study Commission

FOR the purpose of requiring the County Commissioners of Allegany County to set the compensation of certain officials, subject to certain limitations; altering the membership and duties of the Allegany County Salary Study Commission; requiring the County Commissioners to take certain actions concerning the implementation of this Act; providing for the appointment of substitute citizen members of the Salary Study Commission under a certain situation; restricting the membership of the Salary Study Commission; amending certain provisions in the Annotated Code of Maryland and the Public Local Laws of Allegany County to provide that certain salaries are set by the County Commissioners in accordance with this Act; providing that the salary changes under this Act may not apply to the salary or compensation of certain incumbent public officers; maintaining certain salaries in effect on the effective date of this Act; defining certain terms; clarifying language; and generally relating to the Allegany County Salary Study Commission and the setting of salaries of certain public officials by the County Commissioners of Allegany County.
