- (D) (1) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT THE COMMISSION MEMBERS RECOMMENDED BY EACH ORGANIZATION.
- (2) IF ANY ORGANIZATION FAILS TO RECOMMEND AN APPOINTEE TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS BY AUGUST 1, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT A SUBSTITUTE CITIZEN MEMBER TO THE COMMISSION TO SERVE THROUGH THE FOLLOWING JANUARY 30.
- (3) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OR (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE:
- (I) AN ALLEGANY COUNTY OFFICIAL OR AN EMPLOYEE OF ALLEGANY COUNTY; OR
- (II) AN OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF ANY OFFICE STUDIED BY THE COMMISSION.
- (4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL MAKE THEIR APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMISSION FINAL BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 1992, AND BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30 EVERY 4TH YEAR THEREAFTER.
- (E) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- (F) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

11-104.

- (A) THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1993, AND BEFORE JANUARY 1 EVERY 4TH YEAR THEREAFTER.
- (B) FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ARE A QUORUM. 11–105.
 - (A) THE COMMISSION SHALL STUDY THE SALARIES OF:
- (1) THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;
 - (2) THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;
- (3) THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS;
- (4) THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS;
- (5) THE JUDGES OF THE ORPHANS' COURT IN ALLEGANY COUNTY; AND
 - (6) THE SHERIFF OF ALLEGANY COUNTY.
