

(B) BEFORE JANUARY 30, 1993, AND BEFORE JANUARY 30 EVERY 4TH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING SALARIES OF THE OFFICES IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

11-106.

(A) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL SET BY LOCAL LAW THE SALARY FOR EACH OFFICE INCLUDED IN THE RECOMMENDATIONS:

(1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND

(2) WITH RESPECT TO A PUBLIC OFFICIAL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE III. § 35 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

(B) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ACCEPT, REDUCE, OR REJECT BUT MAY NOT INCREASE THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

(b) In Allegany County the annual salary of [each member] THE MEMBERS OF the Board of License Commissioners [is \$3,600] SHALL BE SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 24, TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE CODE.

Article 33 - Election Code

2-3.

(a) Each member of the boards of the several political subdivisions of the State shall receive an annual salary of not less than the following amounts:

(1) Allegany County: [\$1,080] THE MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 24, TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE CODE.

(b) (1) The Sheriff of Allegany County shall receive [a] THE salary [of at least \$32,000, the exact amount to be] set by the County Commissioners [from time to time] IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 24, TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE CODE.
