SALARY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 24, TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND. THE SALARIES ARE TO BE PAID ON A BIWEEKLY BASIS.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salaries of the members of the Board of License Commissioners of Allegany County specified in Chapter 62 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1985 shall remain in effect until altered in accordance with the procedures set forth in this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salaries in effect for members of the Allegany County Board of Education on the effective date of this Act shall remain in effect until the implementation of the procedures set forth in this Act and for the remainder of the members' then current terms.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salaries of the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Allegany County in effect on the effective date of this Act shall remain in effect until the implementation of the procedures set forth in this Act and for the remainder of the Board members' then current terms.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salaries of the judges of the Orphans' Court for Allegany County specified in Chapter 21 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1986 shall remain in effect until the implementation of the procedures set forth in this Act and for the remainder of the judges' then current terms.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salary of the Sheriff of Allegany County in effect on the effective date of this Act shall remain in effect until the implementation of the procedures set forth in this Act and for the remainder of the Sheriff's then current term.

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the salaries of the County Commissioners of Allegany County in effect on the effective date of this Act shall remain in effect until the implementation of the procedures set forth in this Act and for the remainder of the County Commissioners' then current term.

SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, a local law enacted by the County Commissioners of Allegany County affecting the salary or compensation of any public officer mentioned in this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the public officer in office on the effective date of the local law, unless the term of the public officer is fixed by law to exceed 4 years; but the provisions of the local law required by this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the public officer affected shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
