SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That ~~the Commercial Hazardous Waste Incineration Task Force convened under Section 1 of this Act shall be staffed by the Research Division of the Department of Legislative Reference~~ this Act in no way derogates the existing authority of the Department to issue, suspend, or deny any permit concerning incineration or disposal of hazardous waste controlled hazardous substances.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall remain effective until the end of September 30, 1995, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses

MC 235-92

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Board of License Commissioners to issue one additional alcoholic beverages license of the same class for use in a restaurant under certain circumstances; providing for a limited number of exemptions; establishing certain license issuance qualifications for the restaurant; and providing for the effective date of this Act.
