(a-2) (6) (I) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ~~AN INDIVIDUAL OR CORPORATION THAT~~ A PERSON WHO HOLDS A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED 1 ADDITIONAL CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN A RESTAURANT IF THE RESTAURANT IS LOCATED: MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF ITEM (H) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

(H) ~~THE RESTAURANT SHALL:~~

1. ~~BE LOCATED~~ 1. WITHIN AN ENCLOSED RETAIL MALL HAVING AT LEAST 250,000 SQUARE FEET OF GROSS FLOOR AREA; AND

2. ~~BE LOCATED~~ WITHIN CBD ZONED PROPERTY IN SILVER SPRING.

(II) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT GRANT MORE THAN 2 EXEMPTIONS UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 199

(House Bill 1414)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County Land Recordation – Indexes – Required Information

FOR the purpose of requiring the clerk of the circuit court for Baltimore County to include in each entry in a land record index ~~a description of the property that is the subject of the entry; requiring a description of property under this Act to contain certain information~~ certain property identifiers; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the indexing of land records in Baltimore County.
