SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

ARTICLE 78D - BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN COUNCIL

1.

IN THIS ARTICLE, "COUNCIL" MEANS THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN COUNCIL.

2

- (A) A BODY CORPORATE AND POLITIC TO BE KNOWN AS THE "BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN COUNCIL" IS CREATED.
 - (B) THE COUNCIL IS NOT AN AGENCY OF THE STATE.
 - (C) THE COUNCIL SHALL:
- (1) SERVE AS A FORUM FOR LOCAL OFFICIALS AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES TO IDENTIFY AND ADDRESS PROBLEMS IN THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN REGION;
- (2) PROVIDE A CENTRAL SOURCE OF INFORMATION AND COORDINATION FOR FASHIONING RESPONSES TO NEEDS IN THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN REGION; AND
- (3) ASSIST GENERALLY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS IN DEVELOPING REGIONAL POLICIES, PRIORITIZING REGIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS, AND DEVELOPING REGIONAL STRATEGIES IN THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN REGION.

3.

- (A) THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF 6 THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED AS FOLLOWS PROVIDED:
- (1) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;
- (2) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF BALTIMORE COUNTY;
- (3) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF HARFORD COUNTY;
- (4) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF HOWARD COUNTY;
- (5) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF BALTIMORE; $\frac{AND}{D}$
- (6) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY; AND
