- (7) OTHER MEMBERS AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNCIL CHARTER.
- (B) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS INDEFINITE.
- (C) EACH MEMBER SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE MEMBER'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
- (D) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE MEMBERS SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN WHO SHALL SERVE A 1 YEAR TERM. THE CHAIRMANSHIP SHALL ROTATE ANNUALLY SO THAT A REPRESENTATIVE OF EACH JURISDICTION CHAIRS THE COUNCIL ONCE EVERY 6 YEARS AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNCIL CHARTER.
 - (E) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR REASONABLE EXPENSES.

4.

- (A) THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST OUARTERLY.
- (B) FOUR A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING BUSINESS.
- (C) TO BE EFFECTIVE, ACTIONS OF THE COUNCIL SHALL RECEIVE THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST 4 THE MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS.

5.

- (A) THE COUNCIL MAY:
 - (1) ADOPT AND ALTER AN OFFICIAL SEAL;
- (2) SUE, BE SUED, PLEAD, AND BE IMPLEADED, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF SUBTITLE 4 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE:
- (3) <u>SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION</u>, ADOPT A CHARTER, BYLAWS, REGULATIONS, AND GUIDELINES TO CARRY OUT ITS POWERS TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF THE COUNCIL;
- (4) ACQUIRE, HOLD, LEASE, USE, ENCUMBER, TRANSFER, OR DISPOSE OF ANY REAL, PERSONAL, OR OTHER PROPERTY;
- (5) ENTER INTO CONTRACTS AND LEASES OF ANY KIND AND EXECUTE ALL INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT TO: CARRY OUT ITS POWERS TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF THE COUNCIL;
 - (6) HIRE AND FIRE EMPLOYEES;
