(C) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY BOARD, THE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL ELECT ITS CHAIRMAN, WHO SHALL SERVE A TERM OF ONE YEAR AS CHAIRMAN. THE CHAIRMANSHIP SHALL ROTATE ANNUALLY AMONG THE JURISDICTIONS SO THAT EVERY JURISDICTION CHAIRS THE ADVISORY BOARD ONCE EVERY 6 YEARS AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNCIL CHARTER.
