

CHAPTER 208

(Senate Bill 286)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City Community College – Continuation

FOR the purpose of renaming the New Community College of Baltimore as Baltimore City Community College; continuing Baltimore City Community College as a permanent State institution of higher education; repealing the authority of the Maryland Higher Education Commission to adopt certain regulations; establishing certain findings and policies as the basis for the existence of Baltimore City Community College; repealing obsolete language; establishing the terms of the Board of Trustees of Baltimore City Community College; requiring Baltimore City to provide certain financial support; and generally relating to the continuation of Baltimore City Community College as a permanent State institution of higher education.
