

(iv) An assessment of academic programs, personnel, and general policies; and

(v) A long-term projection of enrollment and overall financial conditions, including operational costs, capital needs, and the level of State, federal, and private sector support.

(d) During the 3-year period, the New Community College shall be governed by a board of trustees and a president.

(e) The plan required under subsection (c) of this section and legislation to implement the plan shall be submitted to the Governor and General Assembly by October 31, 1991 for consideration at the 1992 Session of the General Assembly.]

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Board of Trustees" means the Board of Trustees of [the New Community College of Baltimore] BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

(c) "College" means [the New Community College of Baltimore] BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE NEW COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BALTIMORE.

(d) "Commission" means the Maryland Higher Education Commission.

(e) "Officer" means the president and the vice presidents of the College AND OTHER OFFICERS AS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

(f) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Higher Education.

16-603.

(a) There is a [New Community College of Baltimore] BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE NEW COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BALTIMORE located in Baltimore City, Maryland, which shall, with other educational institutions, provide the services and programs described in § 10-211 of this article.

(b) The College is an institution of higher education of the State of Maryland.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the [New Community] College [of Baltimore] shall be classified as a "local educational agency (LEA)", as defined in federal law, for purposes of federal subsidies, grants, contracts, and other programs of support for which a community college is eligible.

16-604.

(a) [(1)] The government of the College is vested in the Board of Trustees of the [New Community] College [of Baltimore].
