- [(2) The Board of Trustees is a body that exists from June 1, 1990 to June 30, 1993, unless otherwise extended by law.]
- (b) (1) The Board of Trustees consists of 9 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
 - (2) Of the members:
 - (i) Each shall be a resident of the State;
 - (ii) A majority shall be residents of Baltimore City; and
- (iii) 1 shall be a regularly enrolled student in good standing at the College.
- (c) (1) The student member shall have a term of 1 year beginning June 1 and ending on May 30.
- (2) Except for the student member, [the term is from June 1, 1990 through June 30, 1993] THE TERM IS 6 YEARS FROM JULY 1 OF THE YEAR OF APPOINTMENT AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (3) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED, AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1992.
- [(3)] (4) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term or until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (5) A MEMBER MAY BE REAPPOINTED BUT MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE FULL TERMS.
 - (d) Each member of the Board of Trustees:
 - (1) Serves without compensation; and
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations.
 - (e) Each year the Board of Trustees:
 - (1) Shall elect one of its nonstudent members as its chairman; and
 - (2) May elect any other officers it requires.
- (f) (1) The Board of Trustees shall meet regularly at such times and places as it determines.
- (2) The Board of Trustees may adopt rules for the conduct of its meetings and the transaction of business.
- (g) A majority of the voting members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
