Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the provisions of Subtitle 4 of this title and §§ 16-201, 16-202, 16-203, 16-204, and 16-206 of this article do not apply to the College.

[16-609.

- (a) (1) Except for an officer of the Community College of Baltimore, the Board of Trustees shall offer employment from July 1, 1990 through December 31, 1990, subject to the terms and conditions set by the Board of Trustees to any former faculty member or other employee of the Community College of Baltimore who was employed by the Community College of Baltimore during the most recent academic year.
- (2) Any employee or faculty member offered employment in accordance with paragraph (1) of this subsection may be employed without further examination or qualification.
- (b) Each position held by any person employed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section shall be in the unclassified service until such time, if any, as the position is classified by the Department of Personnel.
- (c) Before January 1, 1991 the Department of Personnel shall review the positions at the New Community College of Baltimore and on January 1, 1991, classify each position not excluded by law from the classified service.
- (d) Any person employed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section and holding on January 1, 1991 a position classified in accordance with subsection (c) of this section may continue to hold that position without further examination or probation and shall have all the rights of the class to which the position is allocated.
- (e) Beginning January 1, 1991 the creation and filling of all classified positions shall be in accordance with Article 64A of the Code and the rules adopted under that article.
- (f) The terms and conditions of employment and the compensation of any officer or faculty of the New Community College of Baltimore shall be set by the Board of Trustees.
- (g) The provisions of this section supersede any other applicable provisions of law.l

16-610.

(a) [(1) Subject to the approval of the Commission, the Board of Trustees of the New Community College of Baltimore, the City of Baltimore, and the Board of Trustees of the Community College of Baltimore shall enter into an agreement effective July 1, 1990 for the purpose of transferring all of the property, assets, licenses, credits, and rights of the Community College of Baltimore to the Board of Trustees of the New Community College of Baltimore. Upon execution of the agreement, the City of Baltimore and the Board of Trustees of the Community College of Baltimore shall make, and the Board of
