

(ii) For each employee who chooses to remain a member of the Baltimore City Retirement plan in accordance with this paragraph, the State shall contribute annually to the Baltimore City Retirement Plan on behalf of the employee an amount equal to the lesser of the contribution the State would otherwise have made on behalf of each employee of the State to the State Pension System or the rate required for the Baltimore City Retirement Plan.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the current members of the Board of Trustees of the College shall expire on June 30, 1992. Those terms shall not be deemed full terms for purposes of Section 16-604(d) of the Education Article. Except for the student member, board members serving on June 30, 1992 shall be reappointed for additional terms commencing July 1, 1992. Of these reappointments to the board, 5 shall be for terms of 2 to 6 years, respectively, and 3 shall be for terms of 1 year.

~~SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the City of Baltimore shall expend at least \$300,000 in each fiscal year for tuition reimbursement or scholarships to attend classes at Baltimore City Community College.~~

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the City of Baltimore shall be responsible for providing at least \$600,000 in each fiscal year to support education at the Baltimore City Community College. Of this amount, in each fiscal year, at least \$300,000 shall be expended for tuition reimbursement or scholarships to attend classes at the Baltimore City Community College and the remaining balance shall be expended in a manner consistent with the educational mission of the Baltimore City Community College. The source of the \$600,000 is not limited to tax or fee revenues generated by the City of Baltimore.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That neither the State, nor the Board of Trustees of Baltimore City Community College, nor Baltimore City Community College is responsible for any judgment, obligation, damage, or liability arising from any employment act, occurrence, or transaction taken by the Community College of Baltimore, the Board of Trustees of the Community College of Baltimore, the City of Baltimore, or their agents.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
