Preamble

WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has adopted the following schools for success goals for public education by the year 2000:

(1) 95% of Maryland's students will start first grade ready to learn as demonstrated by readiness assessments;

(2) Maryland will rank in the top 5 states in the nation on national and international comparisons of student achievement and other measures of student success;

(3) 100% of Maryland's students will be functionally literate in reading, writing, mathematics, and citizenship;
