Article 8 - Cecil County

H. DELINQUENT TAXES, INTEREST DUE ON THE TAXES, AND ANY COSTS OR PENALTIES DUE AND OWING ON OR AFTER MAY 1 OF EACH YEAR SHALL BE PAID BY CASH, CASHIER'S CHECK, CERTIFIED CHECK, OR MONEY ORDER.

(Senate Bill 87)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Use of Highway User Revenues
