- (7) As to Baltimore City, for fiscal year 1993 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 1997[:
- (i) For fiscal year 1991, costs incurred in providing traffic crossing guards; and
- (ii) For fiscal years 1991 and 1992], students' costs of discounted Mass Transit Administration fares for eligible public school students in Baltimore City.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 216

(Senate Bill 90)

AN ACT concerning

Board of Public Accountancy - Examination

FOR the purpose of authorizing requiring the Board of Public Accountancy to adopt regulations that identify the parts of the examination prepared by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants that the Board will use to qualify candidates for licensure in Maryland; authorizing requiring the Board to waive a part of the examination for certain persons; and generally relating to the examination for licensure of certified public accountants.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

2 - 305.

- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.
- (b) The Board shall give examinations to applicants twice a year, at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (c) The Board shall give each qualified applicant notice of the time and place of examination.
