

(E) THE DECISION OF THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL IS THE FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION AND THE DECISION IS NOT SUBJECT TO APPEAL UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 224

(Senate Bill 121)

AN ACT concerning

Transportation – Police Jurisdiction and Issuance of Citations

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Toll Facilities Police and the Maryland Port Administration Police to render mutual aid under certain circumstances; authorizing the Administrator of the Maryland Aviation Administration to designate certain employees of the Administration to issue citations for certain violations under certain circumstances; requiring the issuance of citations under this Act to comply with certain provisions of law; requiring the Maryland Aviation Administrator to adopt certain regulations; providing for the effective dates of provisions of this Act; and generally relating to police jurisdiction and the authority to designate certain employees to exercise certain powers.
