AN ACT concerning

Insurance – Liability Insurance Data Reporting

FOR the purpose of repealing reporting requirements for certain insurers regarding certain liability insurance data; repealing the reporting requirements of a certain Act; and generally relating to liability insurance data reporting.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A – Insurance Code

[241A.

(a) In this section, “state” means any state of the United States or the District of Columbia.

(b) An insurer shall submit an annual report containing its liability insurance experience in this State and other states.

(c) A report filed under this section shall cover the following lines of insurance:

- (1) Commercial automobile insurance no-fault (personal injury protection);
- (2) Other commercial automobile insurance liability including commercial automobile physical damage;
- (3) Commercial multiple peril insurance;
- (4) Products liability insurance;
- (5) Medical malpractice insurance;
