SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

The provisions of this subtitle creating the Maryland Home Improvement Commission and relating to the regulation of home improvement businesses and any regulations promulgated under this subtitle are of no effect and may not be enforced after July 1, [1992] 2002. OCTOBER 1, 1994.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Regulation

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate on July 1, [1992] 2002. OCTOBER 1, 1994.
