(Senate Bill 437)

AN ACT concerning

Public Restrooms – ~~Number~~ Distribution of Sanitary Fixtures

~~FOR the purpose of directing that the State Board of Plumbing of the Department of Licensing and Regulation require certain places where the public congregates of public entertainment to have a certain number of sanitary fixtures; requiring that certain places where the public congregates of public entertainment provide sanitary fixtures in a certain ratio; specifying that the provisions of this Act apply to construction or renovation begun after a certain date; specifying that the provisions of this Act apply to certain counties unless the county adopts a certain local plumbing code; requiring persons who build or remodel certain buildings or structures to meet the standards of this Act and the State Plumbing Code; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the provision of sanitary fixtures in places where the public congregates of public entertainment requiring that the number of toilets provided in certain public restrooms for women be no less than the combined number of toilets and urinals provided in certain public restrooms for men; specifying that the provisions of this Act apply to places of public entertainment for which a construction permit is issued after a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the distribution of sanitary fixtures in public restrooms in places of public entertainment.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
