- (1) RESTORATION OR RENOVATION OF STRUCTURES, INCLUDING RESTORATION OR RENOVATION WHICH INVOLVES 100% OF THE PREVIOUSLY EXISTING STRUCTURE; OR
 - (2) AN ADDITION TO ANY STRUCTURE.
