- (I) [a] A list of qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary and the Governor by the Maryland Nurses Association, Inc.[The number of names on the list shall be five times the number of vacancies.]; AND
- (II) ANY LIST OF QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS THAT MAY HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY ANY PERSON WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
- (2) The Governor shall appoint the licensed practical nurse members, with the advice of the Secretary, from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary and the Governor by the Maryland Licensed Practical Nurse Association, Inc. The number of names on the list shall be five times the number of vacancies.
- (3) THE LISTS SUBMITTED BY THE MARYLAND NURSES ASSOCIATION, INC. AND THE MARYLAND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE ASSOCIATION, INC. SHALL EACH CONTAIN THAT NUMBER OF NAMES WHICH IS 5 TIMES THE NUMBER OF VACANCIES.
- [(3)] (4) The Governor may request an additional list of five nominees for each vacancy.
- [(4)] (5) The Governor shall make the appointment for each vacancy-from the original list or the additional list.
- [(5)] (6) The Governor shall appoint the consumer members with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT, BUREAU, OR AGENCY.
 - (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" INCLUDES:
- (I) A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY;
 - (II) A SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
 - (III) A STATE'S ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; AND
 - (IV) THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
