(B) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT RECEIVES A COMPLAINT OF DEATH OR BODILY HARM <u>ALLEGEDLY</u> CAUSED BY A NURSE WHO IS LICENSED OR CERTIFIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 8 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE SHALL <del>COORDINATE</del> ANY CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION OF THE NURSE WITH <u>NOTIFY</u> THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING OF THE COMPLAINT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

## **CHAPTER 256**

(Senate Bill 471)

AN ACT concerning

## Georgetown Hill Child Care Center, Inc. Loan of 1990

FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 457 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1990, the Georgetown Hill Child Care Center, Inc. Loan of 1990, to extend the time for the Georgetown Hill Child Care Center, Inc. to provide certain evidence of a matching fund to the Board of Public Works.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 457 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1990

Section 1

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Chapter 457 of the Acts of 1990

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Georgetown Hill Child Care Center, Inc. Loan of 1990 in the total principal amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8–117 through 8–124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 8–122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
