(2) THE NUMBER OF A WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE POLICY OR BINDER.

1-206. FAILURE TO GET LICENSE FROM DEPARTMENT IN TIMELY MANNER.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON WHO MUST HAVE A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS ARTICLE BUT DOES NOT GET THE LICENSE ON TIME SHALL PAY, IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIRED LICENSE FEE, A LATE FEE.

(B) AMOUNT OF LATE FEE.

THE LATE FEE SHALL BE THE SUM OF:

(1) UP TO 20% OF THE REQUIRED LICENSE FEE FOR THE CALENDAR MONTH FOLLOWING THE CALENDAR MONTH WHEN THE REQUIRED LICENSE FEE IS DUE; AND

(2) UP TO 4% OF THE REQUIRED LICENSE FEE FOR EACH CALENDAR MONTH OR PART OF A MONTH AFTER THAT.
