## Article 49D - Office for Children, Youth and Families OUT-OF-STATE PLACEMENT OF CHILDREN

- (A) (1) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "SPECIAL NEEDS" MEANS:
- (I) THAT ALONG WITH HAVING ONE OR MORE OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A CHILD HAS EXPERIENCED CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH PUT THE CHILD AT RISK OF OUT OF STATE PLACEMENT; OR
- (II) NEEDS THE PROGRAMS, SERVICES, OR FUNDING OF ONE OR MORE STATE AGENCIES OR THEIR LOCAL COUNTERPARTS:
- (2) <u>SPECIAL NEEDS INCLUDES A NEED FOR SERVICES FOR THE</u>
  FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
  - (I) MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL DISORDER;
  - (II) EDUCATIONAL HANDICAP;
  - (III) DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY;
  - (IV) SUBSTANCE ABUSE;
  - (V) DELINQUENCY;
- (VI) CONDITIONS THAT REQUIRE SERVICES FROM THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:
  - 1. CHILDREN IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE; OR
  - 2. CHILDREN IN NEED OF SUPERVISION; OR
- (VII) ANY OTHER CONDITION AS DEFINED UNDER THE PLAN DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- (A) (B) (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DECLARES THAT IT IS THE POLICY OF THIS STATE:
- (1) TO THE EXTENT THAT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, TO PROVIDE FOR AND ENCOURAGE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CONTINUUM OF QUALITY EDUCATION, TREATMENT, AND RESIDENTIAL SERVICES FOR THE CHILDREN OF THIS STATE;
- (2) TO PROVIDE SERVICES IN THE LEAST RESTRICTIVE ENVIRONMENT WITHIN THE STATE TO SERVE CHILDREN:
  - (I) IN THEIR HOMES; OR
