11-103.

- (A) A BOARD OF TRUSTEES, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, SHALL CONTROL THE TRUST AND SHALL EXERCISE ALL OF ITS CORPORATE POWERS.
- (B) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL CONSIST OF 11 VOTING MEMBERS AND, AS EX OFFICIO NONVOTING MEMBERS, THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, AND A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.
- (C) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE OF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - (1) TITLE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN THE STATE;
  - (2) THE MARYLAND LOW INCOME HOUSING COALITION;
  - (3) FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS DOING BUSINESS IN THE STATE;
  - (4) LOCAL GOVERNMENTS;
  - (5) NONPROFIT HOUSING DEVELOPERS:
  - (6) FOR PROFIT HOUSING DEVELOPERS;
  - (7) THE MARYLAND HOUSING POLICY COMMISSION;
  - (8) PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITIES;
  - (9) THE MARYLAND HOUSING RESOURCE CORPORATION;
  - (10) SOCIAL SERVICES PROVIDERS; AND
  - (11) THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- (D) (1) WHEN MAKING APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, THE GOVERNOR SHALL GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO GEOGRAPHIC REPRESENTATION OF THE STATE.
- (2) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT 1 OF THE TRUSTEES TO SERVE AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- (E) (1) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY ACT WITH A MAJORITY VOTE OF A QUORUM OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- (2) A QUORUM SHALL CONSIST OF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTING TRUSTEES THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
  - (F) (1) THE TERM OF A TRUSTEE IS 4 YEARS.
