SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

- (a) In Part I of this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (c) "Commission" means the State Health Resources Planning Commission. 19-124.
- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "RELATED INSTITUTION" MEANS AN INSTITUTION THAT IS LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS:
 - (I) A COMPREHENSIVE CARE FACILITY; OR
 - (II) AN EXTENDED CARE FACILITY; OR
 - (III) A DOMICILIARY CARE FACILITY.
 - (3) "NURSING CARE" MEANS:
- (I) SKILLED NURSING CARE REQUIRING 24 HOURS OF SUPERVISION AND TREATMENT BY A REGISTERED NURSE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A PHYSICIAN:
- (II) INTERMEDIATE CARE FOR PERSONS WHO CANNOT LIVE ALONE;
- (III) CUSTODIAL CARE FOR PERSONS NEEDING SUPERVISION AND HELP WITH ACTIVITIES OF DAILY—LIVING SUCH AS EATING, DRESSING, BATHING, OR MOBILITY; AND
 - (IV) DOMICILIARY CARE.
- (B) EACH RELATED INSTITUTION THAT PROVIDES NURSING CARE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION A YEARLY REPORT DETAILING:
- (1) THE COSTS INCURRED AND CHARGES RATES PAID BY EACH CATEGORY OF PAYOR, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO:
 - (I) THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM;
 - (II) MEDICARE;
