SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for Fiscal Year 1993 only, the Governor shall transfer to the General Fund:—

~~(a)~~ (a) \$5,000,000 ~~(a)~~ \$4,520,000 \$4,100,000 of the funds in the account of the Law Enforcement and Correctional Training Fund established under Article 41, § 4-1301 of the Code; ;

~~(b)~~ ~~\$1,900,000 of the funds in the account of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Fund established under § 2-505 of the Agriculture Article;~~

~~(c)~~ (b) \$1,000,000 of the funds in the account of the Environmental Trust Fund established under § 3-302 of the Natural Resources Article; and

~~(d)~~ (c) \$500,000 of the funds in the account of the Waterway Improvement Fund established under § 8-707 of the Natural Resources Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of State law:

(a) For Fiscal Year 1993, the State shall pay the social security contributions based on the wage base for Fiscal Year 1993, except to the extent that the wage base includes increases in salary other than those associated with any performance, longevity, or individual salary increase for any employee of any Board of Education, Library Board of Trustees, or Community College Board of Trustees implemented in Fiscal Year 1992 or Fiscal Year 1993.

(b) For Fiscal Year 1993, the Board of Trustees of the Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems shall determine the basis for calculating any allowance needed to make the calculation in subsection (a) of this section and notify the State Superintendent of Schools and the Secretary of Higher Education of this basis for State aid purposes.

(c) For purposes of this section:

(1) "Board of Education" means the board of education of a county and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for any Baltimore City public school system employee.

(2) "Board of Library Trustees" means the board of trustees of a county public library system or a county library agency and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for any Baltimore City public library system employee.
