AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the provisions of § 13-209(c)(4) of the Tax - Property Article or any other provision of law, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1992 only, the revenue received from the State transfer tax after appropriations for the purposes provided by § 13-209(b) of the Tax - Property Article shall be distributed as follows:~~

~~(a) \$10,500,000 for the purposes specified in Title 5, Subtitle 9 (Program Open Space) of the Natural Resources Article, \$5,250,000 to the accounts for State Projects and \$5,250,000 to the accounts for Local Projects;~~

~~(b) \$3,000,000 to the Agricultural Land Preservation Fund established under § 2-505 of the Agriculture Article;~~

~~(c) \$1,000,000 to the Heritage Conservation Fund established under § 5-1501 of the Natural Resources Article;~~

~~(d) \$1,000,000 for reduction of State debt authorized under the Outdoor Recreation Land Loan of 1969; and~~

~~(e) the balance to the General Fund.~~

~~(a) \$16,750,000 for the purposes specified in Title 5, Subtitle 9 (Program Open Space) of the Natural Resources Article, with:~~
