- (i) In a county that has one or more community colleges, the board of community college trustees for the county; or
- (ii) Where 2 or more counties establish a region to support a regional community college, the board of regional community college trustees.
- (2) "Community college" means a community college established under Title 16 of the Education Article but does not include the New Community College of Baltimore.
- (3) "County share" means the total amount of money for operating funds provided each fiscal year to a board by the county that supports the community college or colleges or, in the case of a regional community college, the total amount of money for operating funds provided each fiscal year to the board by all counties that support the regional community college.
- (4) "State share" means the amount of money for community college operating funds to be provided each fiscal year to a board by the State.
- (b) For Fiscal Year 1993, in order for a board to receive an increase in the State share, a county is not required to comply with the maintenance of effort provisions of \\$ 16-403(c) of the Education Article, as enacted by Chapter 465 of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Regular Session of 1991. Beginning in Fiscal Year 1994, the required county share shall be not less than the Fiscal Year 1993 county share.
- SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law and for Fiscal Year 1993 only, salaries of State employees that are determined with reference to the salaries of Baltimore City or county employees who perform the same or similar tasks shall not be increased from the Fiscal Year 1992 amount greater than those in effect on June 30, 1992.
- SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law and for Fiscal Year 1993 only, the salaries of positions in the Executive Pay Plan established under Article 64 64A, § 27(a)(2) of the Code may not be increased beyond the amount in effect June 30, 1992; provided, however, that if a position in the Executive Pay Plan becomes vacant during Fiscal Year 1993, the salary with respect to recruitment shall be established in accordance with the provisions of Article 64A, § 27(a)(2)(v) and (vi) of the Code.
- SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for Fiscal Year 1993, the following restrictions shall apply to the distribution of State aid to a unit of local government:

(a) In this section:

(1) (i) "General salary increase" means any action by a unit of local government which has the effect of increasing salary compensation for all or designated classes of employees under that unit during Fiscal Year 1993.
