~~(3) "Board of education" means the board of education of a county and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for a Baltimore City public school system employee.~~

~~(4) "Board of library trustees" means the board of trustees of a county public library system or a county library agency and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for a Baltimore City public library system employee.~~

~~(5) (i) "State aid" means:~~

~~1. For a board of education, all appropriations pursuant to statutory formulas for State aid for public schools for a fiscal year, except aid to support school construction as provided in Title 5, Subtitle 3 of the Education Article;~~

~~2. For a board of library trustees, all appropriations pursuant to statutory formulas for State aid for county public libraries for a fiscal year;~~

~~3. For a community college board of trustees all appropriations pursuant to statutory formulas for State aid for community colleges for a fiscal year; and~~

~~4. For any other segment of a unit of local government, all appropriations pursuant to statutory formulas for State aid to local governments for a fiscal year, except that provided in items 1, 2, and 3 of this subparagraph.~~
