- (1) "Board of Education" means the board of education of a county and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for any Baltimore City public school system employee.
- (2) "Board of Library Trustees" means the board of trustees of a county public library system or a county library agency and includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for any Baltimore City public library system employee.

## SECTION 13 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for:

- (a) For Fiscal Year 1994 only, the Governor shall include an appropriation to the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve Fund established under § 7-311 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, in an amount equivalent to the unappropriated general fund surplus as of June 30, 1992. The amount appropriated under this section shall be in addition to the amount required to be appropriated under § 7-311 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (b) For Fiscal Year 1995 only, the Governor shall include an appropriation to the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve Fund established under § 7-311 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, in an amount equivalent to the unappropriated general fund surplus as of June 30, 1993, including any revenues derived from the sales and use tax collected from out-of-state vendors for mail-order purchases made by consumers in the state (commonly referred to as National Bellas Hess sales). The amount appropriated under this section shall be in addition to any amount required to be appropriated under § 7-311 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

SECTION 14 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

6 303

- (a) An individual employed as a teacher, librarian, principal, director of education, or supervisor of vocational education on the staffs of the following institutions or in the following programs shall be paid an annual salary of not less than the salary received by a public school teacher or public school librarian of similar training and experience in the county where the institution is located:
  - (1) Boys' Village of Maryland;
  - (2) Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School:
  - (3) Victor Cullen School:
- (4) Any other institution that is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Resources or the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and
- (5) [Any] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; ANY vocational rehabilitation programs of the State Department of Education[, the Division of Correction of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, or the Patuxent Institution].
