SECTION 15. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 14 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ____ (H.B. 1560) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992, and if Chapter ____ does not become effective, Section 14 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION 46. <u>17 16.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1991

SECTION 23A. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ACT:

- (A) "BOARD OF EDUCATION" MEANS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF A COUNTY AND INCLUDES THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE FOR ANY BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM EMPLOYEE.
- (B) "BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES" MEANS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF A COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM OR A COUNTY LIBRARY AGENCY AND INCLUDES THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE FOR ANY BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM EMPLOYEE.

SECTION 17. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for Fiscal Year 1993 only, the Governor shall transfer to a special fund \$901,000 in aggregate from funds in various accounts established as inmate welfare funds as administered by the Division of Correction of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services or by the Patuxent Institution, which may be expended only by budget amendment for the sole purpose of funding the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board.

SECTION 18. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for Fiscal Year 1993 only:

- (a) As of January 1, 1993, if revenues derived from client fee reimbursements to the Office of the Public Defender for the period July 1, 1992 through December 31, 1992 equal or exceed \$310,000, the Governor may transfer up to \$200,000 in revenues to a special fund as follows:
 - (1) \$100,000 from the first \$310,000 of client fee reimbursements; and
- §310,000. \$100,000 from one-third of the client fee reimbursements that exceed
- (b) The revenues transferred under subsection (a) of this section may be expended only by approved budget amendment for the sole purpose of supplementing the appropriation for the Office of the Public Defender.
