- (b) The deduction under this section is in addition to any other deductions required or fees collected from inmate accounts provided for under the Code.
- (c) The Commissioner of the Division of Correction shall adopt regulations to implement this section in accordance with the provisions of Article 27, § 678B of the Code.
- SECTION 26. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, if legislation altering the local government shares of the following provisions of law fails to take effect by July 1, 1993, for Fiscal Year 1993 only:
- (a) The Governor may not distribute to local governments their shares of the following revenues and shall transfer the amount of the local government shares to the General Fund:
- (1) Abandoned property as provided in § 17–317 of the Commercial Law Article;
- (2) Alcoholic beverage tax revenue from beer as provided in § 2–301 of the Tax General Article;
- (3) Alcoholic beverage tax revenue from distilled spirits as provided in § 2–302 of the Tax General Article;
- (4) Financial institution franchise tax revenue attributable to savings banks and savings and loan associations as provided in § 8–213 of the Tax General Article;
  - (5) Tobacco tax revenue as provided in § 2–1605 of the Tax General Article;
- (6) Filing fees of Maryland corporations as provided in § 2–220 of the Tax Property Article; and
- (7) <u>Transportation revenue sharing account revenues as provided in § 3–401 of</u> the Transportation Article.
- (b) Every agreement made in accordance with Article 88B, Section 63(d) of the Annotated Code, between the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police and the local governing body of a county, including Baltimore City, or a municipality, in which the Maryland State Police will act as and take over all or a portion of the functions of a local police force for the county or municipality, shall provide that:
- (1) The reasonable and proper cost of the Local Division in the Maryland State Police, for and within the county or municipality, be determined by the Superintendent; and
- (2) The county or municipality shall reimburse the Maryland State Police in an amount equal to 100% of the cost so determined, rather than 75% as provided in Article 88B, § 63(d).
- SECTION 27. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, if legislation implementing an early retirement program for State employees fails to take effect for Fiscal Year 1993, any savings resulting from abolishing positions funded with special funds for Fiscal Year 1993 shall be transferred to the General Fund as provided in the section of the Fiscal Year 1993 Budget Bill relating to early retirement.
