AN ACT concerning

Victim Services Program ~~and Criminal Injuries Compensation Board~~ - Transfer to Governor's Office on Justice Administration

FOR the purpose of transferring the Victim Services Program ~~and the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board~~ to be in the Governor's Office of Justice Administration and under the general authority of the Executive Director of the Office; making certain legislative findings; altering the composition of the State Board of Victim Services and the manner of appointment and status of certain members of the Board; repealing the authority of the State Attorney General over the State Board of Victim Services and the Victim Services Coordinator; ~~repealing the authority of the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services over the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board~~; altering the manner of appointment of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board ~~and the~~ Victim Services Coordinator; requiring the Executive Director to submit a certain annual report and requiring the report to be submitted to the Governor in addition to certain other officials reports; providing the Executive Director with certain duties a certain annual report and requiring the report to be submitted to the Governor in addition to certain other officials; defining a certain term; making certain stylistic changes and technical corrections; providing for the effect and construction of this Act; and generally relating to the transfer of the
