other evidence. The powers provided in this subsection may be delegated by the Board to any member or employee [thereof] OF THE BOARD. A summons issued under this subsection shall be regulated by the Maryland Rules of Procedure.

- <u>{(g)}</u> (7) To take or cause to be taken affidavits or depositions within or without the State.
- [(h)] (B) [To render] THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL SUBMIT each year to the Governor[, to the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services,] and, subject to § 2 1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly a written report of the activities of the Board.

(f) The Board members making a decision shall file with the [secretary] EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR a written report setting forth the decision and the reasons [therefor] FOR THE DECISION. After reviewing the records, the [secretary] EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR shall modify, affirm, or reverse the decision of the Board members. The action of the [secretary] EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR in affirming, modifying, or reversing the decision of the Board members shall be final. The claimant shall be furnished with a copy of the final report [upon] ON request.

- (a) In this section, "crime" means an act committed by a person in the State which is a crime:
  - (1) Under Article 27 of the Code; or
  - (2) At common law.
- (b) In addition to any other costs required by law, a circuit court shall impose on a defendant convicted of a crime an additional cost of \$40 in the case.
- (c) In addition to any other costs required by law, the District Court shall impose on a defendant convicted of a crime an additional cost of \$30 in the case.
- (d) (1) All money collected under this section shall be paid to the Comptroller of the State.
- (2) The Comptroller shall deposit \$20 from each fee collected under this section from a circuit court and \$10 from each fee collected under this section from the District Court into the Maryland Victims of Crime Fund established under Article 27, § 764(j) of the Code.
- (3) The Comptroller shall deposit all other moneys collected under this section into the General Fund of the State.
- (4) The Comptroller shall pay out moneys from the Maryland Victims of Crime Fund as approved by the Board of Victim Services under [Title 6.5] §§ 9–1701 THROUGH 9–1708 of the State Government Article.
