8-203. CHAIRMAN.

WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION.

8-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; OFFICE.

(A) QUORUM; VOTING.

(1) A MAJORITY OF THE AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT ACT UNLESS AT LEAST A MAJORITY OF THE AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP CONCUR.

(B) MEETINGS.

(1) THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY HOLD MEETINGS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES IN THE STATE THAT IT DETERMINES.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET; AND

(2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) OFFICE.

THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE ITS OFFICE IN BALTIMORE CITY.
