

(2) A licensee, certificate holder, or registration holder who has been charged under this title or a party to a proceeding before the Board who claims to be aggrieved by the decision of the Board.

[(m)] (O) If any information contained in any medical or hospital document or any other exhibit is otherwise open for disclosure under law, the use of that document or exhibit in any record of the Board or any of its investigatory bodies does not prevent its disclosure in any other proceeding.

14-607.

(A) (1) A person who violates any provision of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or both.

(2) A person who violates any provision of § 14-503 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.

(3) Any person who is required to give notice under § 14-508 ("reporting burn treatment") of this title, and who fails to give the required notice, is liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$100.

(4) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 14-601 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$50,000 TO BE LEVIED BY THE BOARD.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL PAY ANY PENALTY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION INTO THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE FUND.

14-702.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [1993] 2003.

15-302.

(a) To perform delegated medical acts within the scope of this title, a physician assistant shall obtain an approved job description from the Board.

(b) To apply for a job description, a physician assistant shall:

(1) Submit an application to the Board:

(i) Listing all medical acts to be delegated to the physician assistant and the supervision to be performed;

(ii) Describing the setting in which the physician assistant shall practice and the qualifications of the supervising physician;

(iii) Describing the specialized training provided to the physician assistant and the supervision to be provided by the supervising physician; and
