

WHILE EMPLOYED AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL BE COVERED BY A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY LAW.

(E) DUTIES.

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(1) ADMINISTER AND OPERATE THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION;

(2) BE RESPONSIBLE TO THE SECRETARY;

(3) KEEP THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF THE COMMISSION; AND

(4) KEEP THE SEAL OF THE COMMISSION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first and third sentences of former Art. 56, § 252(e), as those sentences related to the executive director, and the first and third sentences and items (1) and (2) of the second sentence of (a).

In subsection (c)(2) of this section, the former reference to expenses "incurred while engaged in the performance of their duties" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to the Standard State Travel Regulations. See SF § 10-203 and COMAR 23.02.01.01 through .12.

In subsection (d) of this section, the introductory phrase, "[w]hile employed as executive director", is substituted for the former phrase "upon entering the performance of his duties" to clarify that the executive director must have coverage throughout the term of employment.

Also in subsection (d) of this section, the standard language "in the form and amount required by law" is substituted for the former incomplete reference to Art. 78A, §§ 46 through 50 of the Code. See also Art. 19, § 20 of the Code and SF §§ 9-107 and 10-203.

In subsection (e)(1) of this section, the duty to "administer and operate the office of the Commission" is substituted for the former duties "[t]ake charge of the office of the Commission" and to be "in complete charge of the day to day operation of such office" for brevity.
