

(F) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1215 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

- (a) A majority of the members then serving on the Board is a quorum.
- (b) The Board shall meet at least four times a year, at the times and places that it determines.
- (c) Each member of the Board is entitled to:
 - (1) Compensation in accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD;
 and
 - (2) Reimbursement for expenses [under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget] AT A RATE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.
- (d) In accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD, the Board may:
 - (1) Employ a staff; and
 - (2) Have available as a consultant a physician licensed by this State.

6-206.

(A) THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF ELECTROLOGISTS FUND.

[(a)] (B) (1) The Board may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services.

(2) The fees charged by the Board shall be set so as to produce funds to approximate the cost of maintaining the Board.

(3) FUNDS TO COVER THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL BE GENERATED BY FEES SET UNDER THIS SECTION.

[(b)] (C) (1) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title [into the General Fund of this] TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE State.

(2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTROLOGISTS FUND.

(D) (1) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.
