

(3) FUNDS TO COVER THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL BE GENERATED BY FEES SET UNDER THIS SECTION.

(C) (1) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title [into the General Fund of this] TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE State.

(2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FUND.

(D) (1) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

~~(1)~~ (2) THE FUND IS A CONTINUING NONLAPSING FUND, NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

~~(2)~~ (3) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE.

(4) NO OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE USED TO SUPPORT THE FUND.

(E) (1) A DESIGNEE OF THE BOARD SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

(2) MONEYS IN THE FUND MAY BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE AUTHORIZED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

(F) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1215 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(a) To apply for a license, an applicant shall:

(1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires;
and

(2) Pay to the Board the application fee set by the Board [in an amount that does not exceed the cost of purchasing and administering the examination].

(b) An application shall be signed and verified by the applicant as to completion of the required clinical training.
