- (2) The Board may hold special meetings, if:
 - (i) Requested by the Secretary; or
- (ii) The Chairman or a majority of the members then serving on the Board consider a meeting to be necessary or advisable.
- (3) Reasonable notice of all Board meetings shall be given in the manner determined by the Board.
 - (c) A member of the Board is entitled to:
- (1) Compensation, in accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD, for each day on which the member is engaged in performing the duties of the member's office; and
- (2) Reimbursement for expenses [under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget] AT A RATE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.
 - (d) (1) The Board may designate one of its staff as Board administrator.
- (2) The Board administrator may be compensated in accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD.
- (3) The Board may employ other staff in accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD.

- (A) THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR PSYCHOLOGISTS FUND.
- [(a)] (B) (1) The Board shall set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services.
- (2) The fees charged shall be set so as to produce revenues that approximate the cost of maintaining the Board.
- (3) FUNDS TO COVER THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL BE GENERATED BY FEES SET UNDER THIS SECTION.
- [(b)] (C) (1) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title [into the General Fund of this] TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE State.
- (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR <u>PSYCOLOGISTS</u> <u>PSYCHOLOGISTS</u> FUND.
- (D) (1) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.
